Recognition Principles in Higher Education

Recognition towards a specific

- Curriculum / Study Programme / Life Long Learning Programme
- Module (or parts of it)

Recognition decision

- Initially done by a person or committee
- Consistent
- Transparent
- Automation / Credentials Clearinghouse

Strategic implications

- Flexible curriculum design can facilitate recognition
- Mandatory Electives (Wahlpflichtbereich)
- Public Recognition Database
- Credit Recognition Agreements





Recognition of Micro-Credentials, Open and Online Learning

Physical Student Mobility: transfer credits	Virtual Student Mobility: transfer credits
between higher education institutions (HEIs)	from online and other non-traditional short learning programmes which might be offered not only by HEIs, but also by
	other education and training sectors
from accredited study programmes	which are typically not higher education accredited
with credits described in ECTS	which are often not described in ECTS, instead use alternative systems of credentials
with controlled assessment environments	where identity verification processes and assessments are more complex and challenging than in face-to-face settings
with learning agreement from home HEI	without formal statement from home HEI about the perception of externally acquired learning
with module description that provides information about workload, learning outcome and assessment conditions	which lack transparency regarding academic content and learning methodologies
→ Trust and Transparency	→ Lack of Trust and Transparency

- modules will be shared and recognised between institutions
- starting with topics such as "European Identity" or "Sustainable Cities"
- experimenting with virtual and hybrid mobility & mixed groups
- expanding to disciplinary modules
- joint degrees
- joint strategic development

Key Elements / Tools

- directory of learning opportunities (= modules) for students
- mobility pathways / learning agreements
- efficient recognition processes




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

4.4. Conditions

UNED Academic Commission might not accept recognition for different reasons (e.g.,

perceived quality, content, assessment method)

A new agreement would be needed for each external course that is being recognised

It would be necessary to compare the proposal applications of both courses approved by both universities, to check if the agreement of each course is annual or

approved by both universities, to check if the agreement of each course is annual of permanent, to establish the same validity in time for this agreement.

Description

UCM

"Professional English" in UNED Abierta, is a MOOC focused on learning English for the workplace organised in communicative situations. "Applied Business English" in Universidad Complutense de Madrid, is a MOOC for applying the language to specific purposes such as business. The agreement would be really helpful for HEIs students, since both courses are MOOCs, are focused on language skills for professional context, and aimed at Spanish speaking students.





SHORT DESCRIPTION OF ECCOE

The increasing unbundling of higher education and the availability of short learning programmes and online MOOCs have undeniable advantages to today's lifelong learners. These more agile means of education are more suitable to address quickly emerging new skills and competencies demanded by the labour market. However, some issues – such as concerns about data protection and privacy or the lack of validation and recognition mechanisms of digital credentials – cause a serious bottleneck to progress. The ECCOE project aims to present a solution to many of these problems with the perspectives of learners, Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) and employers in mind in equal measure.

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
